Grab your readers' attention from the very beginning. Create intrigue, evoke curiosity, or start with a thought-provoking question to engage them immediately.




Rule 3: Use Descriptive Language

Create memorable and relatable characters that your readers will root for. Give them depth, flaws, and aspirations to make them come alive on the page.




Rule 5: Show, Don't Tell
