## **Process of Getting ISO Certification**

Getting ISO Certification may seem complex, but with the guidance from an experienced certification body, the entire process becomes clear, structured, and manageable.

**Client Submit Application for Initial Certification -** Firstly, the client submits their business information and the ISO Standard they want for their organisation.

**Review of the requirement -** After applying, the certification body reviews the application and makes sure the organisation is eligible for the process. Based on that information, they provide a quotation and an audit plan.

Conducting Audits - The audit is typically conducted in two stages, which are

- **Stage 1 -** It is a documentation review where the auditor reviews the documents, procedures and policies that align with the ISO Standards.
- Stage 2 This is the main audit where the auditors visit the
  organisation's premises, observe processes in action and verify
  compliance with the standard.

**Review the area of concern -** If there are any Non-conformities (NCs) found, the organisation must be addressed before certification is granted.

**Audit Report and Decision -** Based on your audit reports, the certification body decides whether the organisation qualifies for ISO certification or not.

**Issuance of Certificate -** If the organisation meets all ISO requirements and has corrected the non-conformities, then the certification body issues the official ISO certificate.

The **cost of ISO Certification** depends on several key factors.

- The type of ISO Standard you choose for your organisation
- Size of the Organisation

- Location
- Chosen Certification body
