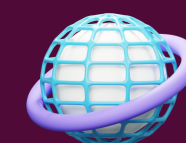

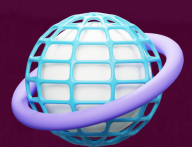

# WHAT IS?

## RICS ASSESSMENT

The RICS Assessment is the rigorous professional gateway to becoming a member of the Royal Institution of Chartered Surveyors. Its primary form, the Assessment of Professional Competence (APC), ensures that candidates possess the technical, ethical, and business skills required to meet global industry standards.

Candidates demonstrate their expertise through a Summary of Experience, a detailed Case Study, and a record of Continuing Professional Development (CPD). The process culminates in a final interview with a panel of RICS assessors.



# WHO NEED?

## RICS ASSESSMENT

### GRADUATES AND EARLY-CAREER PROFESSIONALS

Those with an RICS-accredited degree who need to complete the Assessment of Professional Competence (APC)—usually via a 12 or 24-month structured training period—to become a Chartered Surveyor (MRICS).

### EXPERIENCED INDUSTRY PRACTITIONERS

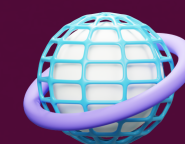
Professionals with 5 to 10+ years of relevant experience (even without an accredited degree) who wish to gain MRICS status through the "Preliminary Review" or "Senior Professional" routes.

### SPECIALISTS AND ACADEMICS

Experts in niche fields—such as valuation, quantity surveying, or geomatics—and university educators who want to demonstrate their authority and high ethical standards within their specific discipline.

### TECHNICAL SUPPORT STAFF

Individuals working in supporting roles within the built environment who aim for the AssocRICS (Associate) qualification to recognize their vocational skills and establish a pathway toward full Chartership.





# WHY NEED?

### ENHANCED EARNING POTENTIAL

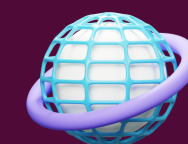
RICS-qualified professionals often earn much higher salaries, usually 20% to 38% more than those without the charter. This is because their expertise is verified, and they can lead complex projects.

# COMPONENTS OF THE RICS APC PROCESS

## WRITTEN SUBMISSIONS

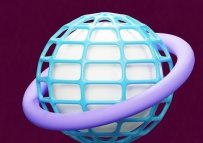
Candidates must produce a Summary of Experience (detailing mandatory and technical competencies across three levels) and a 3,000-word Case Study based on a recent project.

## PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT AND ETHICS

Throughout the process, candidates must maintain a CPD record (typically 48 hours per year) and successfully complete the RICS Professionalism Module.

## THE FINAL ASSESSMENT INTERVIEW

This includes a 10-minute presentation of your Case Study followed by intensive questioning to verify your technical competence, professional integrity, and readiness for MRICS status.





## THE RICS ASSESSMENT FOCUSES ON

### COMPETENCY LEVELS

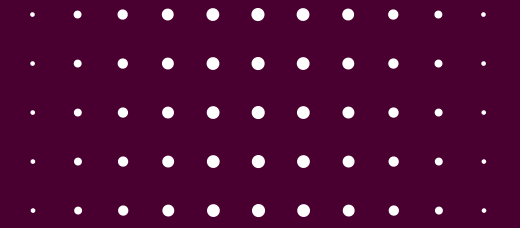
The Assessment focuses on a three-tier hierarchy of expertise: Level 1 (theoretical knowledge), Level 2 (practical application), and Level 3 (providing strategic, reasoned advice to clients or stakeholders).

### TECHNICAL SKILLS

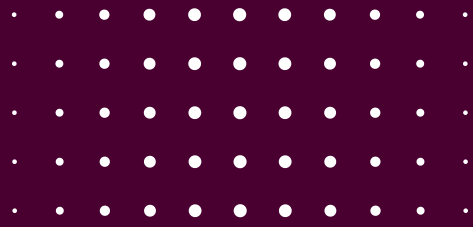
The assessment evaluates both "Mandatory Competencies," such as ethics, teamwork, health, safety, and "Technical Competencies" specific to each pathway, including Quantity Surveying, Valuation, or Project Management.

### PROFESSIONAL ETHICS

A significant focus is on the RICS Rules of Conduct. Candidates must show a strong commitment to ethical practice, conflict of interest management, and public interest, which are strictly verified during the final interview.

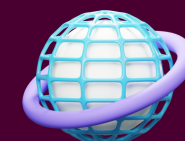
Statistics show that RICS-qualified professionals earn a substantial premium. On average, those with the MRICS designation earn 21% to 38% more than non-chartered counterparts.

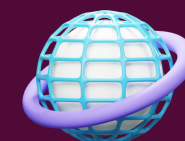
### **STRATEGIC INTERVIEW READINESS**

Learn how to present complex project challenges clearly in a 10-minute talk and confidently defend your professional decisions during a 60-minute panel Q&A that tests your technical skills and industry knowledge.



### **ETHICAL MASTERY**

Internalizing the RICS Rules of Conduct and Global Ethical Standards to ensure that every response and submission reflects the highest level of professional integrity, which is a non-negotiable requirement for achieving MRICS status.





# COST OF RICS ASSESSMENT QUALIFICATION

The cost of RICS Assessment qualification varies by global region and the specific route to membership (e.g., APC, Senior Professional, or Associate). For 2026, RICS has implemented a baseline fee increase in line with inflation (approx. 3.5% in the UK).

## **ENROLMENT AND ASSESSMENT FEES**

Candidates pay a significant upfront fee upon registration, which covers the online ethics module and the final assessment interview.

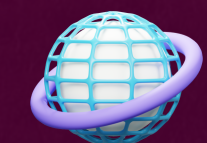
## **ANNUAL CANDIDATE SUBSCRIPTIONS**

While working toward qualification, "APC Candidates" must pay an annual subscription fee to maintain access to the RICS Assessment Platform.

## **ELECTION AND PROFESSIONAL FEES**

Upon passing the assessment, a one-time "Election Fee" is charged to grant the MRICS status.

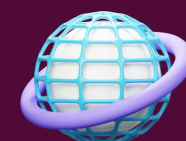

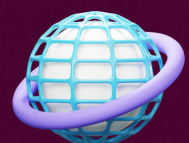
